Now people fill my heart.

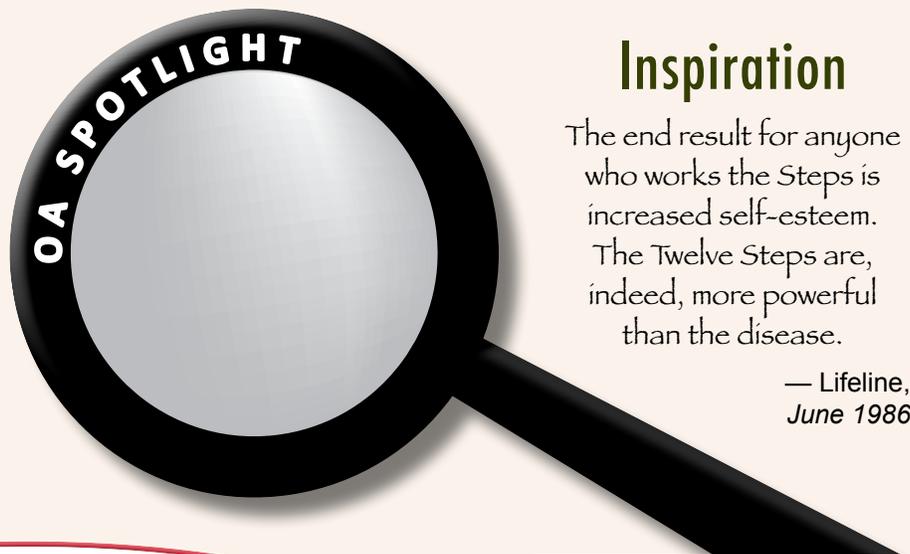
Before OA, food

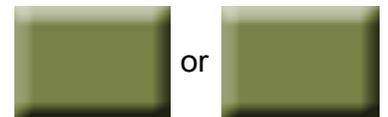
A Call To Service
