From the Region 9 General Officer:

From the Region 9 Secretary:

Report from the Service Task Force:

We have decided to start with one of our projects: the financial glossary. This financial glossary is supposed to help delegates during the presentation and discussion of the R9 budget at the R9 A&C. We have set two deadlines; the first for collecting words/expressions and the second for finding basic explanations to these words/expressions. After the first deadline we'll have a skype meeting and decide when to start our next project.
